Manchester Community Choir is an adult performance choir singing a rich mixture of songs from around the world. We have no party political or religious affiliation. We believe that everyone has a voice, so we don't audition and we learn by ear.

All venues are fully accessible.

We've been singing since January 1999, and are a properly constituted choir. Copies of the constitution are available on request. There are currently over 150 members.

We rehearse **Monthly** from September to July, normally on the **Third Sunday** of the month between 4.00 pm and 6.30 pm. There are occasional extra rehearsals before a performance, day rehearsals & catch up sessions.

### Guidelines

- ♦ We are a performance choir, and we anticipate that our standard will improve with each rehearsal. Therefore we do expect that members will commit themselves to regular rehearsals. We aim to perform at least 6 times a year.

- ♦ In order to have maximum singing time, we start promptly at 4.00pm, and limit the tea break to 15 minutes. Drinks cost 20p.

- ♦ **Performances:**

If we are performing, and you have not rehearsed a particular song, you would be expected **not** to join in - even if you know it, it may be a different version!

- ♦ **Notices:**

Choir business only will be announced before the tea break. Any non-choir notices can be posted in the tea room. Other choir information will also be available on the choir noticeboard.

- ♦ **Registration:** - The year is divided into three 'terms', and new members can join the choir in either September or January.

- ♦ **Trial session:** - if you want to come and see what the choir is like, you can attend the **first session** in **September** at a cost of £3. If you then join, this is deducted from your registration fee.

- ♦ **Young people who want to sing!**
